

Detention Arraignment Held for Lebanon High School Bomb Threat Suspect

Earlier this afternoon, a detention arraignment was held in Warren County Juvenile Court for the 14 year old male defendant who is charged with one count of inducing panic, a second degree felony, for making a bomb threat at Lebanon High School on Wednesday, May 4, 2016. The defendant entered a denial of the charge.

Warren County Juvenile Court Judge Joseph Kirby ordered the defendant held in custody, and further ordered a risk assessment through the court clinic.

Additionally, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 2152.19(A)(8), the defendant's parents were added as parties to the case, thereby making them potentially responsible for costs associated with the incident if the defendant is convicted of the charge.

A further detention hearing will be held on May 12, 2016, at 11:30 a.m., in Warren County Juvenile Court.
