Franklin Township Man Found Guilty of Felonious Assault

Winton Sizemore, 44, of Franklin Township, Ohio, was found guilty today by a Warren County jury of one count of felonious assault, a felony of the 2nd degree; accompanying gun specification; and one count of domestic violence, one count of aggravated menacing, and one count of using weapons while intoxicated, misdemeanors of the 1st degree.

On November 15, 2017, Sizemore got into an argument with his estranged spouse at their Franklin Township home. During the argument, Sizemore threw her to the ground and threatened to shoot her in the face. Sizemore ultimately fired shots at her, however, the bullets narrowly missed her head and passed through a wall into an adjoining room.

Sizemore will be sentenced on January 14, 2019, by Warren County Common Pleas Court Judge Donald E. Oda II.

Warren County Prosecutor David P. Fornshell commended Deputy Stephen Ritchie of the Warren County Sheriff's Office, Assistant Prosecutor Travis Vieux, Victim Witness Services Director Jessi Flint, and Legal Assistant Kathy Fink for their work on the case.
