

Lebanon Man Sentenced to Prison for Killing Father

Freddie Green, 43, of Lebanon, Ohio, was sentenced today to 18 years to life in prison by Warren County Common Pleas Court Judge Timothy Tepe. Green was found guilty of murder with an attached firearm specification last month by a Warren County jury.

On December 2, 2016, Green shot his father, Sydney V. Green, in the back of the head during an argument. Green then waited several hours before calling 911. Green informed the dispatcher that he had shot his father in the head and that his father was dead. When Green was taken into custody, he had both heroin and cocaine in his system.

Warren County Prosecutor David P. Fornshell commended Detective Greg Spanel, Detective John Wetzel, Patrolman Travis O'Neil, Patrolman Patrick Jenkinson, and Patrolman Jeffrey Haller of the Lebanon Police Department, as well as 1st Assistant Prosecutor Steve Knippen, Assistant Prosecutor Karl Harris, Director of Victim Witness Services Jessi Flint, and Legal Assistant Brenda Berry for their work on the case.
