Franklin Robber Sentenced to Prison

Jonathan Dershem, a 36-year-old Franklin man, pled guilty yesterday in the Warren County Court of Common Pleas and was sentenced to prison on one count of aggravated robbery, a felony of the first degree, and a gun specification.

On January 25, 2010, Dershem entered the Union Savings Bank in Franklin, brandished a handgun, and pointed it at a bank employee. Dershem jumped over the bank counter and took approximately \$1,245 in currency, while pointing the gun at employees and customers.

Visiting Judge Timothy Campbell sentenced Dershem to serve five years in prison on the aggravated robbery and one year in prison on the specification, to be served consecutive to each other. Dershem was also ordered to pay restitution of \$1,245 to Union Savings Bank.
