Robber Sentenced to Five Years in Prison

A Lebanon man will serve the next five years in prison for robbing a local gas station.

Daniel Stiles, 46, was sentenced to prison today on one count of aggravated robbery, a felony of the first degree, for robbing the Speedway Station on Columbus Avenue in Lebanon. On August 1, 2011, Stiles entered the station, brandished a knife, and pushed two customers to the ground. He left with approximately \$197.00 from the cash register. Authorities arrested Stiles the following day.

In addition to imposing the prison sentence, Warren County Common Pleas Judge Neal Bronson also ordered Stiles to pay restitution of \$197.00 to Speedway.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant Prosecutor John Arnold and investigated by officers from the Lebanon Police Department.
