Waynesville Murder Suspects Indicted for Capital Offense

During a Monday afternoon press conference, Warren County Prosecutor David P. Fornshell announced nine-count indictments against Austin Gregory Myers and Timothy Edward Mosley for the murder of 18-year-old Justin Back of Wayne Township. The indictments include multiple capital (death penalty) specifications against both Myers and Mosley.

Myers and Mosley were each indicted for two counts of aggravated murder (special felonies), kidnapping (F-1), aggravated robbery (F-1), aggravated burglary (F-1), grand theft of a firearm (F-3), tampering with evidence (F-3), safecracking (F-4), and abuse of a corpse (F-4). The grand jury indictments specify that one count of aggravated murder is for purposely causing the death of Justin Back with prior calculation and design, while the other aggravated murder count is for purposely causing the death of Justin Back while committing aggravated robbery, and/or aggravated burglary, and/or kidnapping. Additionally, the aggravated robbery, aggravated burglary, kidnapping, and grand theft of a firearm counts each include a one-year firearm specification, while the abuse of a corpse count includes a three-year firearm specification.

Myers and Mosley are tentatively scheduled to appear in the Warren County Common Pleas Court on Friday, February 28, 2014 for a hearing on these charges.
