## Men Convicted, Sentenced for Morrow Home Invasion

Larry E. Tumbleson, 42, and Clyde R. Fields, 51, were convicted and sentenced to prison for their roles in a December 2014 home invasion robbery in Morrow. Tumbleson robbed two elderly victims at gunpoint in their home and tied them up with duct tape after one of the victims refused to sell his prescription medications to Tumbleson. In response, Tumbleson stole the victims' prescription medications along with money, jewelry and a computer. He pled guilty to two counts of aggravated robbery with a firearm specification and was sentenced to 13 years in prison and ordered to pay restitution.

Clyde Fields, who did not enter the residence but accompanied Tumbleson and a third codefendant, Thomas L. Fields, to the elderly couple's residence, pled guilty to aggravated robbery. Clyde Fields was sentenced to three years in prison and ordered to pay restitution.

Thomas Fields, 27, the son of Clyde Fields, is a third co-defendant in the case. Thomas Fields is accused of entering the residence with Tumbleson and tying up and robbing the elderly victims. His case is still pending.
