The Warren County Prosecutor's Office recently released its 2019 Annual Report. The 24-page report recounts events from 2019, including significant cases, a synopsis of the work performed by each division in the office, and the office's community involvement.

For calendar year 2019, the Prosecutor's Office was responsible for prosecuting every level of offense, including felonies, juvenile cases, adult misdemeanors, and child support cases. In addition, the office provided legal counsel to 30 county agencies, eight townships, and five public libraries.

The Prosecutor's Office participated in several community events, including the Ohio Law Enforcement Torch Run, National Night Out, National Crime Victims' Rights Week, and the Justin Back Be a Hero Run.

The report highlights the largest overhaul of daily operations in the history of the Warren County Prosecutor's Office, with implementation of a new case management system, Matrix Prosecutor. As 2020 begins, the Prosecutor's Office is committed to further improving efficiency while maintaining the highest level of service to the public.
