

John Reynolds, 53, of Mason, was sentenced today to eighteen years in prison by Judge Donald Oda. Reynolds entered a guilty plea to one count of rape by force of a minor child, and three counts of gross sexual imposition involving three children under the age of thirteen. The children were previously known to Reynolds.

The offenses occurred between the years of 2015 and March of 2022, during which time Reynolds engaged in sexual conduct, and had sexual contact, with the children. Reynolds victimized the four children both at his home in Mason and in his camper. The offenses were disclosed in April of 2022 when the victims confided in their parents.

Reynolds has been designated as a Tier III Sexual Offender requiring him to register with the sheriff's office every 90 days for the remainder of his life.

Warren County Prosecutor David P. Fornshell commended Detective Brian Lewis of the Warren County Sheriff's Office, and the numerous law enforcement officers who assisted in the investigation, Assistant Prosecuting Attorneys Amy Tranter and Travis Vieux, Victim Witness Coordinator Erika Bourelle, and Legal Assistant Brenda Berry for their work on the case.
