

Milk Man Pleads Guilty to Delivering Drugs to Prison

Ray Adams, Jr., 50, of Amanda, Ohio, pled guilty today to illegal conveyance of drugs into a detention facility, a felony of the 3rd degree, in front of Warren County Common Pleas Court Judge Robert W. Peeler.

On January 8, Adams, a delivery driver for United Dairy, was delivering milk to Lebanon Correctional Institution. Investigators approached Adams about conveying contraband into the prison. When the delivery truck was searched, investigators located 30 milk cartons that contained Marihuana, tobacco, and 12 cell phones. Adams said he had been approached by an inmate to bring contraband into the prison. Adams admitted to meeting with an individual the day prior to exchange milk cartons for \$200 and had made approximately \$2,000 delivering contraband to the prison. Adams had \$1,000 cash in his truck which was seized and forfeited.

Adams will be sentenced at a later date.

Fornshell commended Trooper Nathan Stanfield of the Ohio State Highway Patrol, Assistant Prosecutor Christopher Delnicki and Legal Assistant Kathy Fink for their work on the case.
